

RULES

1. Competitors must wear the kilt and highland hose at all times while on the athletic field. Games t-shirts must be worn during competition unless other arrangements have been made with the Athletic Director. If field conditions are muddy, kilts may be optional as directed by Athletic Director.
2. All events will be governed by the rules posted on the Scottish Heavy Athletics (SHA) website (www.scottish-heavies.com).
3. The SHA and the Games organizers reserve the right to test any competitor for the use of steroids and other performance altering substances.
4. Pre-registered athletes will be admitted to the fairgrounds from a Gate List at the main entrance to the fairgrounds. All others must pay entrance fees to enter the fairgrounds.
5. Late entries and on-the-field entries will be accepted if space is available and upon approval of the Athletic Director and Head Judge. Late entries will be required to pay a late fee.
6. Decisions of the Judges and Athletic Director are final.
7. The competition will consist of the traditional Heavy Events of the Scottish Highland Games. However, the actual events of the competition may be adjusted based on field size and other, unforeseen, constraints.
8. All competitors must sign a release waiver prior to warming up or beginning competition.
9. All non-competitors (photographers, coaches, family, etc.) must register with the Athletic Director and have permission from the Athletic Director before stepping onto the athletic field.
